One of Broadway's classic musicals, *Fiddler on the Roof*, is set in the village of Anatevka, Russia in 1905. Tevye, a dairyman, and his wife Golde look to a matchmaker to provide good husbands for their five daughters. But Tevye's tradition and faith are challenged as his daughters choose to marry for love. Tzeitel, the oldest daughter, marries a poor tailor after her hand in marriage has been promised to a well-to-do butcher. Hodel, their second daughter, marries a penniless revolutionary and follows him to Siberia. Chava, the third daughter, marries outside of her religion. Finally, after the Czar's Cossacks destroy his village, Tevye holds on to his faith and his traditions and bravely prepares to take what's left of his family to America.
